I'm writing to ask for your help in keeping Jeff's dream alive. Jeff Braun, a member of the 82<sup>nd</sup> Airborne Paratrooper Division, dreamed of building an orphanage in Honduras. This brave young man, who as a child was adopted from Honduras, had been working on plans for the orphanage when he was killed in Iraq in 2003.

Although Jeff did not live to see his dream come true, local community members joined together to keep Jeff's dream alive. The Jeff Braun Children's Home Foundation was established, and for thirteen years, has been supported by the Keep Jeff's Dream Alive Annual Benefit Auction. Esperanza de Honduras (Hope of Honduras) has served between 24 and 36 young people since 2013 by giving them a home, clothing, education and healthcare. The hope is to expand that number in the next year with the opening of the new facility. The new facility is now housing the school, but is in need of furnishings and a missionary family to care for an additional 24 children.
